Canon Gillespie sent an email from Rome on Manx National Day to wish both Parishes many blessings. He is still hoping to come, but is experiencing problems due to travel restrictions.

Pope urges altar servers to be signs of faith to their parishes

Being an altar server should be a “profession of faith” to the entire parish community, Pope Francis told young men and women participating in Portugal’s annual altar server pilgrimage to Fatima.

“Don’t follow negative people but radiate the light and hope that come from God,” he wrote in a message to the young servers.

The pope asked them to be particularly careful when serving at Mass always to behave in a way that “is fitting in the service of holy things,” especially when they are near the altar, but also when they make the sign of the cross, kneel or are going in the prayers and hymns.

“Put all the enthusiasm of your age into your encounter with Jesus,” the pope told them. “Offer Jesus your hands, your thoughts and your time, and he will not fail to reward you, granting you true joy and making you feel where the most complete happiness is found.” The call to imitate the saints is not a call to become “a photocopy” of any of them, he said, rather it is a call to be like them in finding “the unique and specific path” that God has for each person.
