Canonisation of two young members of the Church today, Sunday 7th September, by Pope Leo.

Blessed Carlo Acutis died aged fifteen. Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati died aged twenty-four. Both will be declared saints by Pope Leo today. Please watch station EWTN to see the services and a plethora of programs on the lives of these extraordinary young people.

Carlo Acutis, born in London, baptised in the Church of Our Lady of Dolours, Fulham Road, died at the age of 15 in 2006, computer savvy and sometimes bullied at school, he is now held before the world as an inspiration for all. Why?

He understood the purpose of life. He said that he was not afraid to die because he had not wasted a minute of his life on things that didn't please God. He had a pathway to follow. He said 'The Eucharist is the highway to heaven'. He lived each day cheerfully, 'always united with Jesus'.

Pier Giorgio Michelangelo Frassati was born in Turin, Italy on April 6, 1901. At an early age, Pier Giorgio joined the Marian Sodality and the Apostleship of Prayer, and obtained permission to receive daily Communion (which was rare at that time). He developed a deep spiritual life which he never hesitated to share with his friends. The Holy Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin were the two poles of his world of prayer. At the age of 17, he joined the St. Vincent de Paul Society and dedicated much of his spare time to serving the sick and the needy, caring for orphans. What little he did have, Pier Giorgio gave to help the poor, even using his bus fare for charity and then running home to be on time for meals.
