From the Presbytery desk......

Advent Charity

In the Lenten Season we often have 'lenten alms' which will go to support a recognised charitable purpose; it is good to do this also in Advent and Christmastide. There are so many different charities and good causes we can - and already do - support – the list of the needs in our local communities and across the world appear endless! It often appears that we can do little with our little resources..... but remember the gospel story of the feeding of the five thousand!!

This year I would suggest that we think about, pray for, and act positively on behalf of the Christian community in the Holy Land. We will, in these coming weeks, hear much about places like Nazareth, Bethlehem and Jerusalem – but the Christian communities living there often find it difficult to thrive because of a multitude of pressures laid on them.

That is where **FRIENDS OF THE HOLY LAND** seeks to help and support the Christian presence in the lands where Christ was born, where he walked and preached, and ultimately where he suffered, died and rose from the dead.

At the beginning of the 20th century, Christians made up roughly 29% of the overall population of the Holy Land. Today they account for less than 2%. Those remaining face such difficult conditions that many will be forced to leave their homes. Soon this dwindling community may cease to exist at all without our help. This fact, little recognised by Christians around the world, is what drives their vision.

FHL provides practical assistance with everyday living costs. They help people access healthcare and education; and to start and grow businesses. At this time they are also providing humanitarian aid to those suffering in the current conflict and violence.

At the very heart of what they do every day is to provide opportunity and hope. They are a community of Christians united in supporting our brothers and sisters in the birthplace of our faith.

Friends of the Holy Land embraces and supports all Christians in the Holy Land. We connect them to a worldwide community of Christians and people of good will who care.
