Island Spirituality Network

Saturday 14th February. St. John's Mill, 10am - 1pm
Revd Professor David Wilkinson of Durham University

An astrophysicist, theologian and Methodist minister his theme for the morning will be
How does God act in the world? Science, miracles and mission.

David holds PhDs in both Theoretical Astrophysics and Systematic Theology and served a Principal of St. John's College, University of Durham for seven years before accepting the invitation to become Director of ECLAS in 2023 (Equipping Christian Leadership on an Age of Science), an international project based at St. John's College. ECLAS seeks to affirm the work of faithful scientists and all who bring their vocation in science to the Church, both as members and active friends of congregations. EC:AS, along with the Church of England and policy advisers, has also renewed calls for a national conversation on the impact of artificial intelligence on the world of work, warning that rapid technological change raises profound questions.

He will be a familiar voice to those who listen to BBC Radio 4's Thought of the Day as he travels widely to speak and broadcast on the relationship of science and faith.

He has written and co-authored several books and is in high demand worldwide as a speaker.
