And on the 7th day...

I'm very conscious of the upheaval our parish communities have experienced since Fr Brian died and I was appointed. The warm welcome and friendliness that have been shown to me are truly Christian. I have tried where possible to maintain continuity. There are, however, personal choices that Fr Brian made that aren't right for me. Fr Brian chose not to take a day off, but from this week it's my intention to take Tuesday off. The tongue in cheek headline for this article is a reminder that even God took a day off.

It's also my intention to reduce the number of weekday Masses and change the time of Wednesday evening. Sadly, the attendance does not justify Mass every day in Ramsey (something no other church on the island has) and to reduce the number of days in the week I'm saying more than one Mass. So the Mass timetable overleaf will be the pattern. It is subject to revision if necessary and to the timing of funerals and other events. I hope you can understand and appreciate why these changes need to be made. I have consulted both the Vicar General of the Archdiocese and other clergy before making them.
